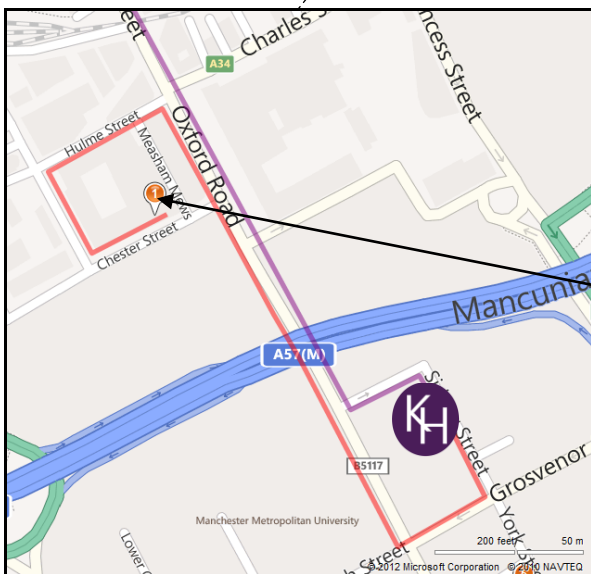
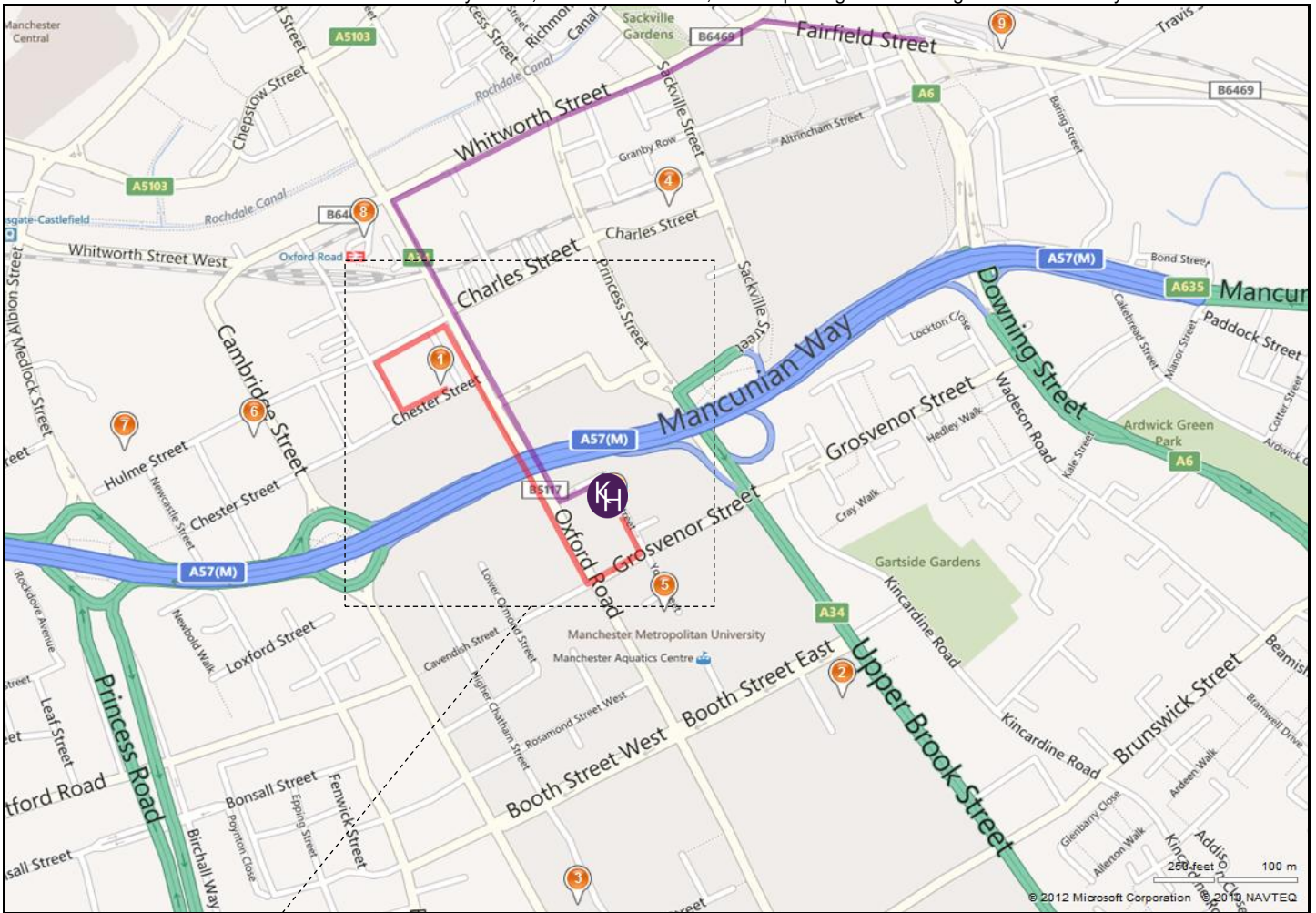

(Follow the Red Route)
 Go along **Oxford Road**, heading North towards the city centre.
 Go under the Mancunian Way flyover and past the MMU John Dalton building on the left.
 Go past Chester Street on the left, as this end of it is a one-way street.
 Go past Subway, The Dancehouse Theatre and Maplin, all on the left.
 Take the next left turn onto **Hulme Street**, before Spar.
 Go past Measham Mews, which is a narrow backstreet on the left.
 Take the next left onto **Lower Ormond Street** (which has no street name signs!)
 Take the next left onto **Chester Street**.
 The NCP car park is just beyond Zouk and Nando's, on the left.

From the Train Stations. (Follow the Purple Route)
8. Manchester Oxford Road Train Station
 Turn right onto **Whitworth Street West**.
 Turn immediate right onto **Oxford Road**, heading South away from the city centre.
 Go under the railway bridge and the Mancunian Way flyover.
 Turn left onto **Sidney Street** and follow the blue "King's Church" pedestrian signs around to the right.

From the Train Stations. (Follow the Purple Route)
9. Manchester Piccadilly Train Station
 From the Fairfield Street exit (by the taxi rank), turn right onto **Fairfield Street**. Cross London Road.
 Take the left fork onto **Whitworth Street**.
 Turn left onto **Oxford Road**, heading South away from the city centre.
 Go under the railway bridge and the Mancunian Way flyover.
 Turn left onto **Sidney Street** and follow the blue "King's Church" pedestrian signs around to the right.

On-Street Parking

Sidney Street has free parking bays, restricted to 2 hours on weekdays 8:00am to 6:00pm. York Street has free parking bays, restricted to 2 hours on weekdays 8:00am to 6:30pm and Saturdays 8:00am to 12:30pm.

Lower Ormond Street, Higher Ormond Street and Lower Chatham Street have similar 2 hour free parking bays with varying restrictions on Saturdays.

On weekdays after 6pm or 6:30pm, Saturdays after 12:30pm, Sundays and bank holidays, parking is allowed on single yellow lines on Oxford Road, Grosvenor Street, Cavendish Street, Higher Ormond Street, Lower Ormond Street and Lower Chatham Street.

Please take great care to read the parking restriction signs if you park in any of the locations listed above.

By Train

Manchester Oxford Road Train Station is 6 minutes walk from King's House. The walking route is described on the first page of this document. King's House is on the right of Sidney Street, opposite the entrance to Sugden Sports Centre.

Manchester Piccadilly Train Station is approximately 18 minutes walk from King's House. Leave the station by the Fairfield Street exit (by the taxi rank). The walking route is described on the first page of this document. King's House is on the right of Sidney Street, opposite the entrance to Sugden Sports Centre.

The alternatives are to get a taxi for around £4 or the 147 bus (Oxford Road Link) for 80p. The bus stop is on Fairfield Street and the 147 runs every 10 minutes weekdays from here along Whitworth Street and then Oxford Road. The closest bus stop to King's House is the Aquatics Centre.

Manchester Victoria Train Station is on the North of the city centre. It is best to get a Metrolink tram to Manchester Piccadilly train station and then follow the directions above, from there.

By Tram

There are Metrolink tram routes to the city centre from Altrincham, Chorlton, Eccles, MediaCity UK and Bury. The closest tram stop to King's House is St.Peter's Square which is approximately 10 minutes walk from King's House.

From St.Peter's Square, turn onto Oxford Street, heading South away from the city centre. Go past the Palace Theatre on the left (after which the road becomes Oxford Road). Go under the railway bridge and the Mancunian Way flyover. Turn left onto Sidney Street and follow the blue "King's Church" pedestrian signs around to the right. King's House is on the right of Sidney Street, opposite the entrance to Sugden Sports Centre.

By Bus

Oxford Road is a main bus corridor into the city centre with most routes ending at Piccadilly Gardens Bus Station. The closest Oxford Road bus stops to King's House are these: the Aquatics Centre (heading South away from the city centre) and All Saints' Park (heading North towards the city centre).

Routes from Piccadilly Gardens, via Oxford Road: 15 & 253 to Flixton. 16, 41 & 263 to Altrincham. 42 & 142 to East Didsbury. 42 & 42A to Stockport and Reddish. 43 & 44 to Manchester Airport. 48 to Northenden. 85 & 86 to Chorlton. 111 & 143 to West Didsbury. 145 to Cheadle Hulme. 157 & X57 to Woodford. 250 & 291 to the Trafford Centre.

Route from Manchester Piccadilly Train Station, via Oxford Road: 147 Oxford Road Link.

Routes from Albert Square, via Oxford Road: 191 & 197 to Stockport.

Routes from Piccadilly Gardens, via Higher Cambridge Street: 99 to Sale. 101, 104 & 109 to Wythenshawe.

By Coach

Manchester Central Coach Station is on Chorlton Street and is approximately 12 minutes walk from King's House. Turn right onto Sackville Street, left onto Portland Street and then left onto Oxford Street, heading South away from the city centre. Go past the Palace Theatre on the left (after which the road becomes Oxford Road). Go under the railway bridge and the Mancunian Way flyover. Turn left onto Sidney Street and follow the blue "King's Church" pedestrian signs around to the right. King's House is on the right of Sidney Street, opposite the entrance to Sugden Sports Centre.

By Car

From the South (M6 then M56)

Leave the M6 at Junction 19 and take the third roundabout exit, to join the A556 Chester Road, signed Manchester, M'cr Airport. Go along the A556 for 3.7 miles until the next roundabout and take the third exit to join the M56, signed Manchester, M'cr Airport. Go along the M56 for 6 miles, passing Manchester Airport at Junction 5, and move to lane 2 (as at Junction 3 the M56 leaves the main carriageway). Stay in lane 2 to join the A5103, signed City centre. Go along the A5103 Princess Parkway (which then becomes Princess Road) for 5 miles, going under the M60 and passing Southern Cemetery, Hough End Playing Fields, a Shell petrol station and Alexandra Park, all on the left. Immediately before Royal Brewery, on the right, turn right onto B5219 Moss Lane East. Go along Moss Lane East for 0.8 miles, until a T-junction with Whitworth Park on the left. Turn left onto Oxford Road. Go along Oxford Road for 1.0 mile, going under a bridge by the University of Manchester and passing The Aquatics Centre, on the right and All Saints Park, on the left. Turn right at traffic lights, just before the MMUnion, on the right, and the Mancunian Way flyover, onto Sidney Street. Go around to the right and King's House is on the right, opposite the entrance to Sugden Sports Centre.

From the East (M62)

There are many routes from this direction but we recommend this one, due to the quality of the roads. Just before Junction 18 on the M62, move to lane 2 to join the M60, signed Ring Road (W), L'pool. Go along the M60 for 7 miles, move to lane 1 just before Junction 12, and leave the M60 to join the M602, signed Salford, M'cr city centre. Follow From the West (M602), below.

From the North West (M6 then M61)

Leave the M6 at Junction 30, signed M61. Go along the M61 to the end. Just before Junction 1, move to lane 3 to take the right fork, to join the M60, signed Ring Road (W & S), M'cr Airport, L'pool. Go along the M60 for 3 miles, move to lane 1 just before Junction 12, and leave the M60 to join the M602, signed Salford, M'cr city centre. Follow From the West (M602), below.

From the West (M62)

Just before Junction 12 on the M62, move to lane 3 to join the M602, signed M'cr city centre, Salford. Follow From the West (M602), below.

From the West (M602)

Go along the M602 to the eastern end, and move to lane 2 just before Junction 3, to join the A57 Regent Road, signed M'cr (C). Go along the A57 for 1.1 miles, passing Sainsbury's, on the left. Move to lane 2 and bend right, going under 2 railway bridges to join the A57(M) Mancunian Way, signed M'cr Airport, Birmingham. Go along the A57(M) for 1.1 miles, going under Chester Road roundabout, over Princess Road and Cambridge Street roundabouts and over Oxford Road. Take the next exit from the A57(M), which is a very tight left fork, signed A34 Wilmslow, Universities. Immediately take another left fork, then turn left onto A34 Brook Street, passing under the Mancunian Way flyover. Turn first right at traffic lights, just before the Oddfellows Hall on the right, signed King's Church, onto Grosvenor Street. Go along Grosvenor Street past The Pub/Zoo, on the right, then turn right onto Oxford Road at traffic lights. Turn right at traffic lights, just after All Saints Park, on the left, before the MMUnion building, on the right, and the Mancunian Way flyover, onto Sidney Street. Go around to the right and King's House is on the right, opposite the entrance to Sugden Sports Centre.
